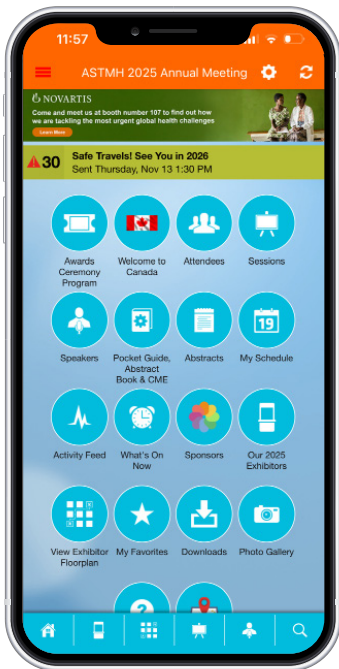
*INNOVATIONS PITCH COMPETITION

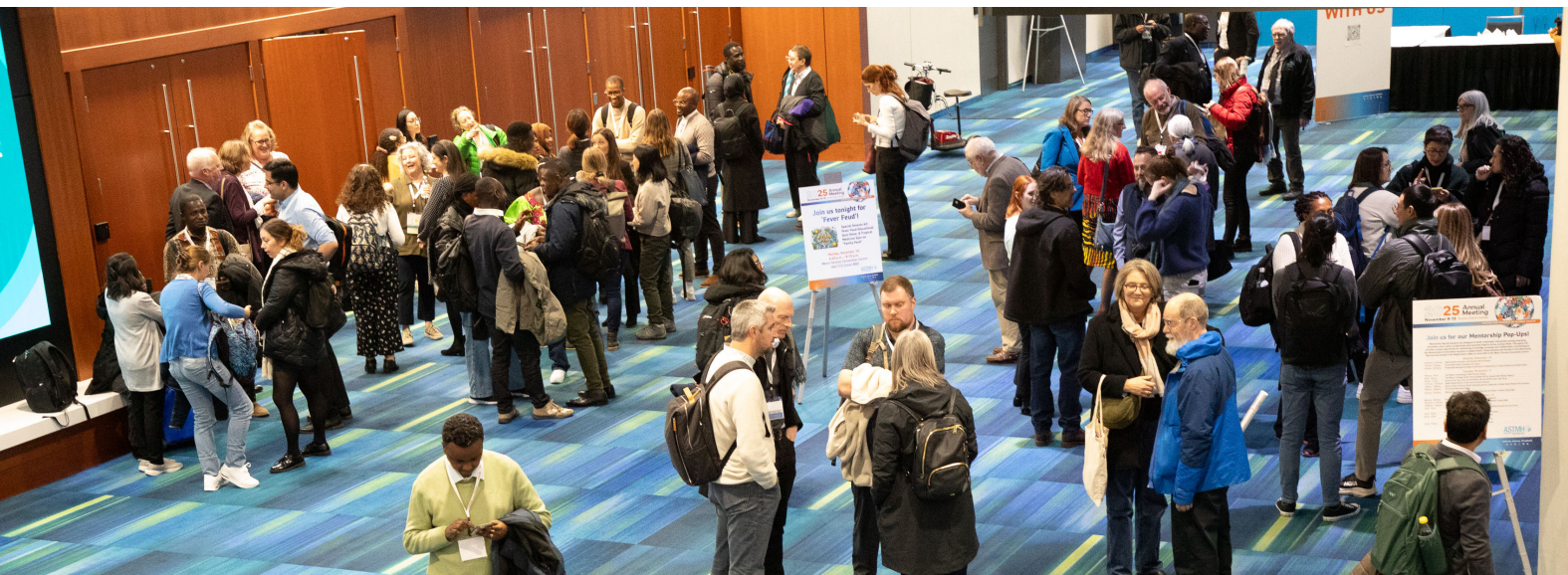

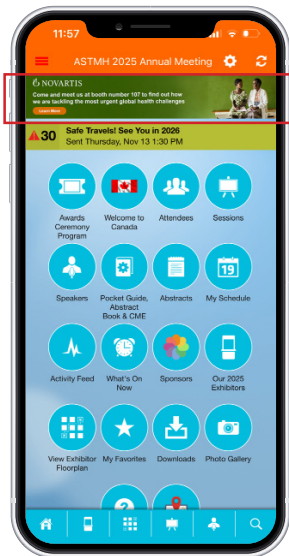

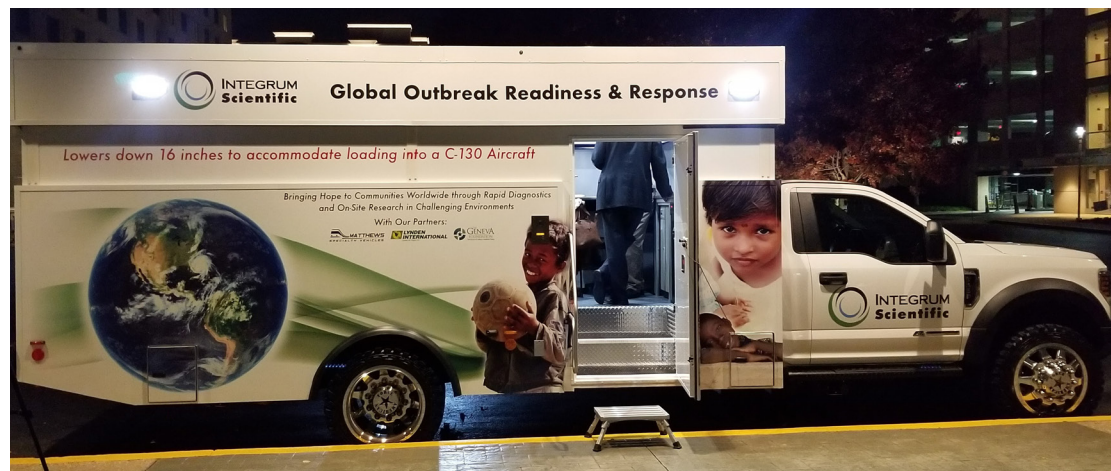


ASTMH Inclusion/Respect Policy
