Call for Volunteers: Clinical Practice Guidelines Subcommittee

The Clinical Group (ACCTMTH) is seeking motivated and engaged members to serve as Co-Chairs and members of the newly formed Clinical Practice Guidelines Subcommittee. The Subcommittee will play a central role in shaping the development of clinical practice guidelines for the Clinical Group and ASTMH. Its responsibilities will include identifying priority topics, establishing standardized processes for guideline development, selecting guideline leadership and panel members, and overseeing the development, review and approval of guidelines. The Clinical Practice Guidelines Subcommittee will also be responsible for establishing the overall framework and providing oversight into guideline development, and it will not require members to have subject matter expertise in any specific disease.

Roles and Responsibilities

Co-Chair

- Provide leadership and strategic direction for the Subcommittee.
- Set meeting agendas and facilitate meetings.
- Coordinate with Society leadership.
- Monitor progress of guideline development projects.
- Ensure adherence to established methodology and standards.

Member

- Participate actively in meetings and discussions.
- Contribute to the selection of guideline chairs and panel members.
- Review and provide input on guideline proposals, drafts and final documents.



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Eligibility and Expectations

- Must be an active member of the Clinical Group.
- Must comply with ASTMH conflict-of-interest requirements.
- Must be able to attend regular meetings and complete additional work outside of meetings as needed.
- Chairs should have prior experience with guideline development and strong leadership and organizational skills.
- An individual may serve on both the Clinical Practice Guidelines Subcommittee and a Guideline Panel; however, they must recuse themselves from any Subcommittee discussions related to that specific guideline.

Term

All positions are for a three-year term, with the option for one renewal.

Selection Process

Interested candidates should submit an [online application](#), including a CV and brief cover letter outlining their interest and relevant experience, by **June 1, 2026**. Selected applicants may be invited for an interview.
